What to do under the conditions -Word for Today (April 15th)

# "Cast thy burden upon the Lord." PSALM 55:22

We must distinguish between the burden-bearing that is right and the burden-bearing that is wrong. We ought never to bear the burden of sin or of doubt, but there are burdens placed on us by God which He does not intend to lift off, He wants us to roll them back on Him. "Cast that He hath given thee upon the Lord" (R.V. marg.). If we undertak work for God and get out of touch with Him, the sense of responsibility will be overwhelmingly crushing; but if we re back on God that which He has put upon us, He takes away the sense of responsibility by bringing in the realization Himself.

Many workers have gone out with high courage a fine impulses, but with no intimate fellowship with Je Christ, and before long they are crushed. They do know what to do with the burden, it produces wearing and people say—"What an embittered end to such beginning!"

"Roll thy burden upon the Lord"—you have been bing it all; deliberately put one end on the shoulder God. "The government shall be upon His should Commit to God "that He hath given thee"; not fling it but put it over onto Him and yourself with it, and the den is lightened by the sense of companionship. Never associate yourself from the burden.
