







"I myself will help you," declares the LORD. (Isaiah 41:14)

This morning let us hear the Lord speak to each one of us: "I myself will help you." "It is a small thing for Me. your Lord, to help you. Consider what I have done already. What! not help you? Why, I bought you with My blood, I have died for you—and if I have done the greater, will I not do the less? It is the least thing I will ever do for you. I have done more, and will do more. Before the world began I chose you. I made the covenant for you. I laid aside My glory and became a man for you. I gave up My life for you And if I did all this, I will surely help you now. In helping you, I am giving you what I have bought for you already. If you needed a thousand times as much help, I would giveit to you. You require little compared with what I am ready to give.
